GENERAL INFORMATION BLANK-To be filled out by the applicant in his own handwriting in ink (not typewritten) and delivered without fail to the principal. It will be observed that this part calls for a considerable amount of information relative to the interests, ideals, and past experiences of the candidate. The applicant may, if he so desires, confer with the principal before filling out the blank, but it is not the desire of the University that the principal correct, criticize, or modify the facts, language, spelling, arrangement, etc., of the applicant's replies to the questions. Page 10 should be read carefully before answering any of the questions. It is desired that the applicant take the blank to his home and read it over with parents or guardian before starting to fill it out.

PERSONAL QUALIFICATIONS BLANK-To be filled out by the high-school principal or by a teacher to be designated by the principal.

PART III

SCHOLARSHIP STANDING AND CERTIFICATE OF RECOMMENDA-TION-To be filled out by the principal after the applicant has completed the first semester of the senior year. No student will be admitted on certificate unless officially recommended by the principal. To be admitted by examination a student must pass fifteen prescribed units.

The principal, not the applicant, is requested to send the completed blank DIRECTLY to the Registrar, University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, Michigan, as soon as possible after the completion of first semester of the senior year, and at least one month before the date on which admission is sought.
